Travel tips

Health resort fee

Following the pattern of 1985's decree, Krynica city council had established a health resort fee that is added to your accommodation fee. Currently it is 3.5 PLN a day per person. Excluded are: hospitalized persons, the visually impaired and their assistants, local real estate tax payers, and the organized groups of school children and youth.

Safety
Krynica is a rather peaceful and tourist-welcoming town, though caution and some common sense are always advisable. Tourist scams are quite rare; nevertheless, if you decide to board at a top-class looking pension that charges a price of a youth hostel, make sure they have a land line telephone connection starting with 018, as a cell phone number only might mean your dream lodging simply doesn't exist. Also, all officially registered taxis should have a licence no. on their side door. All in all, the best option is to make good use of the variety of Krynica Local Life website offers of [accommodation](#) and [services](#).

Emergencies

Krynica operates a full scope of public service, such as police, fire dept., and ambulance. The all-purpose EU emergency no. 112 is sometimes not as efficient as hoped, and the best way to get help is to remember all-national Polish emergency numbers:

997 - police

998 - fire dept. - also takes care of all emergencies requiring use of heavy duty equipment and life-saving skills, such as climbing or operating on water

999 - ambulance

Getting around

If you've come to Krynica by car, please note that the streets of the town are not particularly wide (mostly one lane each side), hence parking is allowed only in the parking zones. Most [hotels and pensions in Krynica](#) have their private parkings, and offer them free of charge to its guests. Also, all the [sports facilities](#) and [ski resorts](#) have ample of parking space. To see the detailed outline of Krynica, go to Local Life Krynica's interactive map.

No car? No worries, as Krynica operates some public transport, however it is not by bus lines as you'd imagine it in a major city, but by regular minivan operators contracted to carry passengers at certain routes. The minivans, more commonly named "minibus" /meenee-boos/; the cars are white and have a plaque with destination behind their windshield instead of a particular line number. To stop a bus you just need to wave, and the ticket is purchased at the driver's. To request a stop say "please stop at the next stop" /po-prosheh nah nahs-tehmpnem psheh-stahnkoo/ - and that's it. The [local minibuses timetables](#) are available only in Polish, but during the day a maximum waiting time is ca. 15 min. The buses operate mostly between the two major ski resorts, stretched between the two opposite edges of the town: the Slotwiny in the northern tip, and the Czarny Potok with Mt. Jaworzyna in the south. The fee starts at 2.5 zł; there are no discounts for children and students. Transporting the skis is allowed, but an extra fee is charged.

[Taxi service](#) in Krynica is also available, but the drivers don't speak English as a rule. Taxi ranks can be found at Kościelna, Kraszewskiego and Piłsudskiego St. The fares start at ca. 10 zł, and the cars are modern and well maintained.

If you'd like to travel in style, you can also book a horse carriage to drive you to your hotel, or any destination in Krynica you wish. The carriage rank is located at Piłsudskiego St, almost opposite the taxis, but if you see a free carriage some place around Krynica, the driver will be more than happy to pick you up on the go.
